This course will:

Course objectives are to enable your Tutors or potential Candidates who wish to become Tutors or Trainers to:

- Build upon knowledge of principles of learning, teaching assessment and evaluation

Course content:

Course assessment includes a portfolio of evidence to include:

- A reflective journal
- A written assignment for each section
- Written reports of teaching observations
- The completion of practical activities to cover the evidence required

CIBTAC Examination requirements:

- External verification visit will be made by a CIBTAC International Examiner to the Centre to sample portfolios of evidence and observe micro teaching presentations
- Pass mark of 60%

Course requirements:

- Guided learning hours – minimum 150 hours
- Attendance may be part or full time – dependant on centres choice
- All sections of the course must be completed successfully to be awarded the CIBTAC Diploma
- Candidates should be holders of an International Beauty/Complementary/Spa therapy, Anatomy and Physiology or Nutrition qualification together with a minimum of two years of work experience within a beauty therapy environment
- **Candidates need to have teaching practice sessions available at a recognised CIBTAC Centre**
